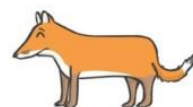


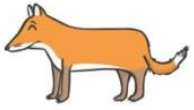
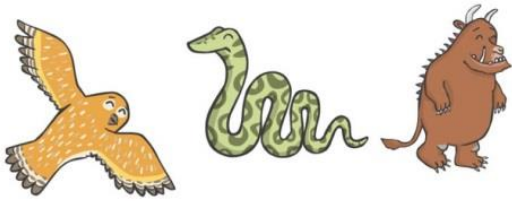
Our topic will begin with:

A Gruffalo Banquet held in the afternoon of Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> October.

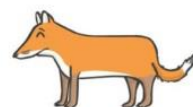


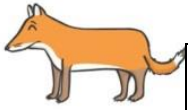


You can support your child's learning at home by:
