And


- New Life/ Farm animals and their young

A Stunning Start helping the Fairy Godmother to find 'missing' objects from fairy tales hidden around the school.

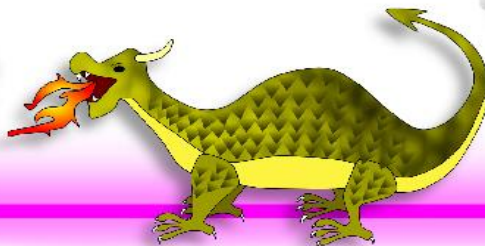
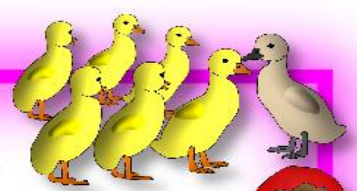
Our topic will end with:
