

What are we learning this week? 4th February

This week we are continuing with reading Fairy Tales with a focus on Goldilocks and The Three Bears. We shall be threading bears, investigating porridge and making chairs from boxes. In Literacy, the children will be writing a sorry letter from Goldilocks and using their sounds to help them build words. In Art, we will be using pastels to make observational drawings of bears.

In Science/KUW we will be looking at different types of materials: shiny, bumpy, hard, soft, smooth and making bear collages from these. On Wednesday the children will be tasting porridge with a variety of toppings. The children will be using thermometers to check the temperature of the porridge.



In maths we will be looking at sharing in maths and how to share equally. We will be looking at how we share. We will be asking questions such as; could we share 6 milks equally with 4 bears? Why not?
