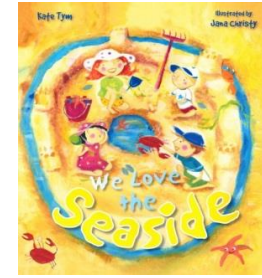


What are we learning this week? 4/6/18
