

What are we learning this week? 6th February

This week we are continuing with reading Fairy Tales with a focus on Goldilocks and The Three Bears. We shall be threading bears, investigating porridge and making chairs from boxes. In Literacy, the children will be writing a sorry letter from Goldilocks and using their sounds to help them build words. In Art, we will be using pastels to make observational drawings of bears.

In Science/KUW we will be looking at different types of materials: shiny, bumpy, hard, soft, smooth and making bear collages from these. On Wednesday the children will be tasting porridge with a variety of toppings. On Friday we will finish this story with a teddy bear's picnic, please can you send in a **small** bear for Friday.



In maths we will be looking at capacity and using vocabulary such as full, empty, half full. In the water tray the children will be investigating wet and dry oats and counting out cutlery. Later in the week, we will be measuring the height of our teddy bears and using the vocabulary of taller and shorter.
