


What are we learning this week?

Welcome to the start of a new week. It has been lovely seeing parents pop into see the chicks at the end of the day. In Literacy this week, we will be looking at two stories including Chicken Licken and The Little Red Hen. The children will be acting out the stories and using stick puppets to retell these familiar picture books. In the writing areas, we will be writing speech bubbles, chick information booklets, as well as labelling pictures of chicks after looking in non-fiction books.

We will be celebrating World Maths Day on Thursday. The children are invited to wear something with numbers on. Our work will centre on a book called 'Spinderella'. We will be using this lovely book to help with addition and subtraction.

In PE we will be following a programme called 'Good To Be Me'. This is a dance and healthy eating programme.
