What are we learning this week? 13/6/17



This week we will looking at the story of The Rainbow Fish. We will be having a maths focus activity this week which will concentrate on counting on 1/2/3 more by adding more shiny scales to the rainbow fish. Later in the week, we will recording addition number sentences using the shiny scales. You may wish to follow up our addition work at home using the language of 'adding 1 more, 2 more, 3 more'. In our writing area this week, we will be looking at writing about our dads ready for Father's Day as well as re-telling the story of The Rainbow Fish.

In art, we will be making Father's Day cards, 3D Rainbow Fish out of plastic drinks bottles. (Please can you send in an empty plastic bottle this week). We will also be printing Rainbow Fish using celery!
