Things you could try at home...

Have two plates with biscuits. Count out 10 biscuits and place on the first plate, second plate empty...Record as number sentence.

There are 10 biscuits on this plate and zero on this plate altogether there are 10 biscuits.

If I move one biscuit to the other plate how many will there be? Have I added or taken away any biscuits?

There are 9 biscuits on the first plate and 1 on the other plate, altogether there are 10 biscuits. Practice writing as number sentences.
