

What are we learning this week? 14/11/16

This week we will be continuing with our work on People who help us. We are looking closely at Firefighters, car rescuers and refuse collectors. Our focus work will be around Maths looking at adding on from a given number. In phonics we will be looking at the sounds: v, k and l. If your child is ready to start blending you may like to look at the words: vet, van, kid and kit. Sentence work from previous week: The vet fed the bad dog.

In art and Science we are starting to look this week at creating fire art mixing fire colours. We will be junk modelling fire engines and trucks. If you have any cardboard tubes or shoe boxes we would be very grateful to receive them. In Knowledge and understanding of the world we are looking animals that live in cold places and animals that live in warm climates.



In maths we will be looking at counting on from a given number. You may like to try this at home starting from 2 for example and seeing if your child can count on to ten. You can try this with different numbers. In PE we are continuing to look at balancing on one foot and balancing bean bags on our arms, legs and heads as we move around the hall.

In phonics we have taught the following sounds so far: a, i, m, s, t, n, p, o, b, c, g, h, d, f, e, v, k, l. You may like to use flash cards or magnetic letters at home to work on the sounds taught so far.
