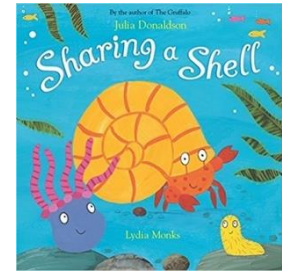


What are we learning this week? 17/6/19
