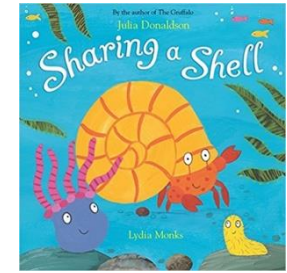


What are we learning this week? 18/6/18

We hope you are all managing to purchase Graduation tickets via Parent Pay. (Wednesday 11th July, 9.15am start).

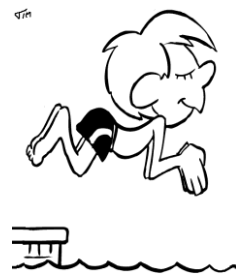
The Proms is on Thursday 19th July starting at 1.45pm tickets will be sold on the gate.
