Welcome to the start of a new week. This week we will be continuing to look for signs of Spring around our school and in our outside area. We will continue with our investigation into Spring plants and changes we see happening around us. In class, we will be starting to make our Easter/Mother's Day cards and write the inserts. The children are making very good progress with their handwriting. Many thanks for all your support with the homework we send home each week. **Friday, is Red Nose Day. *The children are invited to come to school on Friday dressed in a bright top and/or with funny hair!***

In maths this week, we will be looking at shapes. We will focus on 2D and 3D shapes, naming and describing properties. You may like to follow this up at home asking, 'how many sides does each shape have?'

In the car, you might like to play the game of guess my shape where you describe the shape and your child guesses - 'I have 3 sides and 3 corners what am I?'



The Easter Parade is on Wednesday 22nd March starting at 2pm in the hall. We hope the bonnets and baskets are coming on ok. The children will do a short parade around the hall for you and then sing some spring songs. After this there will be a raffle and a chance to guess the weight of a cake as well as guess the name of a fluffy chick.
