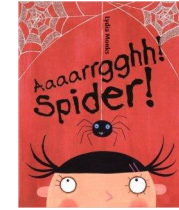


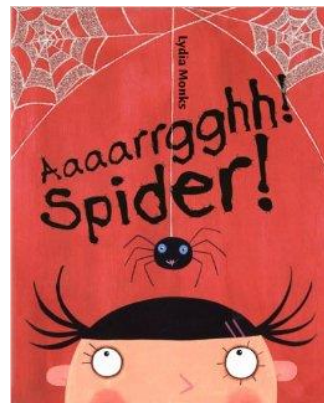
What are we learning this week?

This week we will be looking at the story of 'Aaaarrgghh Spider!'. It is our last fictional book looking at mini-beasts this week. After half term, we will be starting a new topic called 'Oh I do like to be beside the seaside'. This week we will be looking at writing thought bubbles connected to the spider in the story. Later in the week we will be making up alliterative sentences 'Sammy spider sings songs to Sally'. At the end of the week we will be looking at adjectives to describe the spider in the story. Our topic for this half term will end with dressing up as a bug on Wednesday.

In art, we will be making glitter and glue webs as well as paper plate webs. In our Knowledge of the World work, we will be going on a spider web hunt and thinking about where spiders live. We will be learning two songs called 'There's a spider on the floor' and 'Incy Wincy Spider' Thank you.

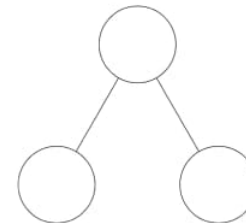


We have some exciting Child Initiated Tasks planned this week, including:

- Sewing a web

In Maths this week: We will be continuing on with work done in the previous week on number bonds of 10. We will be introducing the concept of part/ part whole... We can show this by having a tower of 10 cubes and explaining that this is the whole and break into 2 parts. **"This is the whole (10 cubes) these are part of the whole(2 towers)"**

Put them onto the cherry model...



Record as addition number sentence.. Eg $8 + 2 = 10$
Repeat with tower of 10 again...
