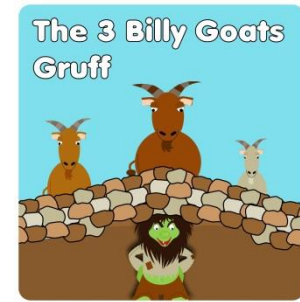


What are we learning this week?

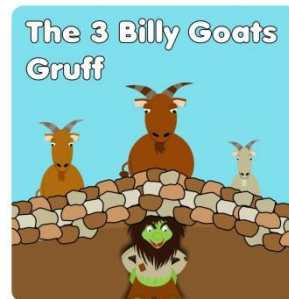

This week we will be continuing with our look at Fairy Tales. We will be concentrating on the story, 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff'. The children will be writing sorry letters from the Troll to the goats. We will be looking at bridges and bridges in the local area. We will also be making bridges from recyclable materials. The children will be introduced to adjectives when describing the Troll. In phonics, we will continue with the extended code and introduce the children to the 'sh' and 'th' sounds.

- We have some exciting Child Initiated Tasks planned this week, including:
- Bridge building using toilet and kitchen rolls, spaghetti and joining materials.
- In Knowledge and Understanding, we will be looking at butterfly bridges and drawing our own maps and bridges using art straws.

In art, we will be making paper plate goats mixing our own shades of grey with white and black paint. Later in the week, we will be making large collages of both the goats and Troll. On Tuesday, we will be using our hands to create handprint goats.



In maths, we will be looking at subtraction when we ask the children to take away flowers in the meadow and see how many they are left with.
