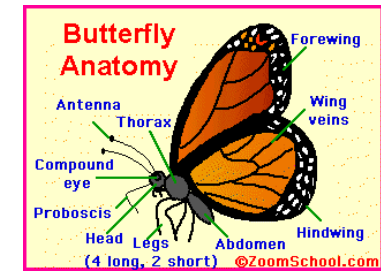


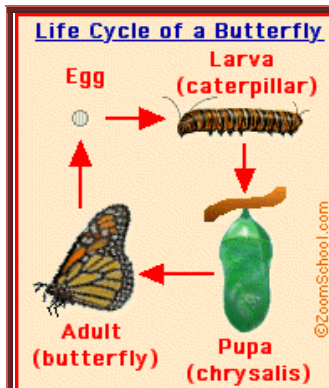
What are we learning this week?

We will be looking at the features of a fictional text and asking questions about the front cover, the title the blurb (back page), illustrations etc. During free activities, the children will be sequencing the story and writing lists explaining what the caterpillar ate all week. We have a full week of Knowledge and Understanding, starting with looking at the Life cycle of A butterfly and moving onto looking at the sun and moon and the changes that happen in a day.

In art, we will be painting and collaging caterpillars and butterflies. We will be making caterpillars out of paper chains and later in the week, using balloons to print caterpillars. A busy and enjoyable week ahead. Thank you for your support.
