

What are we learning this week?

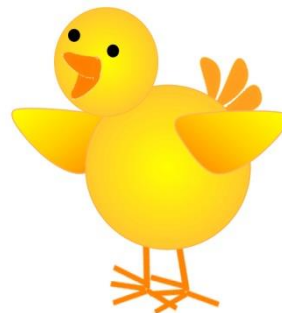

This week we will be welcoming our Chicks this week into Foundation. We are expecting around ten eggs which will hatch over the first week. The children will have opportunities to observe the changes and think about ways of caring for the small chicks. Our Literacy work will focus on non-fiction looking at labelling the eggs and chicks as well as looking at non-fiction books and comparing them with fictional books. Also in Literacy, we will be encouraging the children to start to write their 'news' following a weekend or holiday. We are starting to encourage longer sentence writing in focus groups as well as child initiated activities.

This week we are looking at the story of Chicken Licken. We will be painting chicks and looking for signs of spring as we paint daffodils and create clay nests. In maths this week we will be looking at doubling numbers and continuing to count in 2s. If you have Numicon at home please see staff to find out how this can help.
