

What are we learning this week?

Welcome to the start of a new week. On Monday we will be having a visit from Riverside Tennis who will be working with the children on developing their tennis skills. If the weather is ok, we will be outside therefore; please can the children come to school on Monday dressed in their outdoor PE kits with jogging bottoms and jogging tops with their coats on top.

We will be looking at the Easter story this week and sequencing the story. This will be part of our RE work as we continue to look at the Bible and the stories Jesus told.

In maths this week, we will be looking at shapes. We will focus on 2D and 3D shapes, naming and describing properties. You may like to follow this up at home asking, 'how many sides does each shape have?'

In the car, you might like to play the game of guess my shape where you describe the shape and your child guesses - 'I have 3 sides and 3 corners what am I?'
