We shall also be assisting the children with writing their names. We will start our initial assessments of alphabet sound recognition and following that we will begin to send home reading books. In art, we will be designing and making Gruffalo masks, and creating Gruffalo paintings by mixing paints to create colours and textures. Later in the week, we will be making a group collage of the Gruffalo characters.
