What are we learning this week? 28/1/19



This week we will be focusing on the Fairy Tale 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. In our writing areas, we will be showing the children how to write speech bubbles, sequence the story, use describing words to describe a character as well as think of rhyming words to go with the story e.g. green-bean cow-how, Jack-black etc. In phonics, we will be recapping the sounds taught so far this week and then some children will be moving onto learning ch, sh and th sounds.

In art, we will be colour mixing to paint green beanstalks and leaves. On Tuesday we will be free painting pictures of the giant. On Wednesday, we will be painting castles in the sky! Our Knowledge and understanding for this week will focus on planting beans.

We have some exciting Child Initiated Tasks planned this week, including:

- Making Giant soup with lentils
- Cheerio Towers with spaghetti for Jack to climb.

In Maths this week: We will be looking at taking away (subtraction) using coins. Our theme is Fairy Tales, so we will be using the 'Giant's coins' to look at how we can take some away and be left with an amount. We will be encouraging the children to make up their own number stories.
