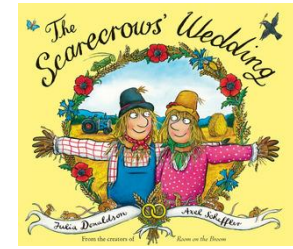


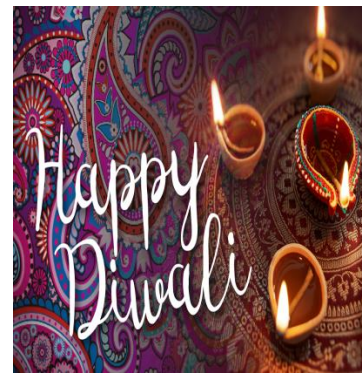
What are we learning this week?

On the first week back, we will be looking at the Julia Donaldson story of *The Scarecrow's Wedding*. In our Literacy work this week, we will be reading the story and looking at writing wedding invitations and party invites. We will also be writing lists for the wedding party happening in school on Friday. On Friday, the children are invited to come dressed in party/wedding clothes for the day as they will be 'attending' the Scarecrow's wedding in our school hall.
