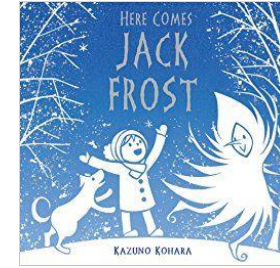


What are we learning this week?

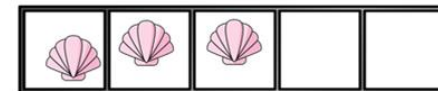
This week we will be looking at the story Jack Frost fitting in nicely as the weather continues to get colder! The children will be painting and collaging Jack Frost pictures using cold colours and cold coloured materials. We will be taking a look at snowflakes and the patterns they make as well as completing some lovely threaded snowflakes. The children will be looking in their literacy at describing words to describe Jack Frost using and writing words such as: cold, icy, blue, freezing etc.

We will continue the winter theme by looking at hibernating animals, winter clothes to keep us warm and a close look at ice and melting and freezing. In maths this week we will be looking at finding 1 less than a number. Questions you can ask your child on this topic will be: Are the numbers getting bigger or smaller, are we counting forwards or backwards on the numberline? What is 1 less than 5? Etc. You could use toys, buttons, pasta etc to play...
