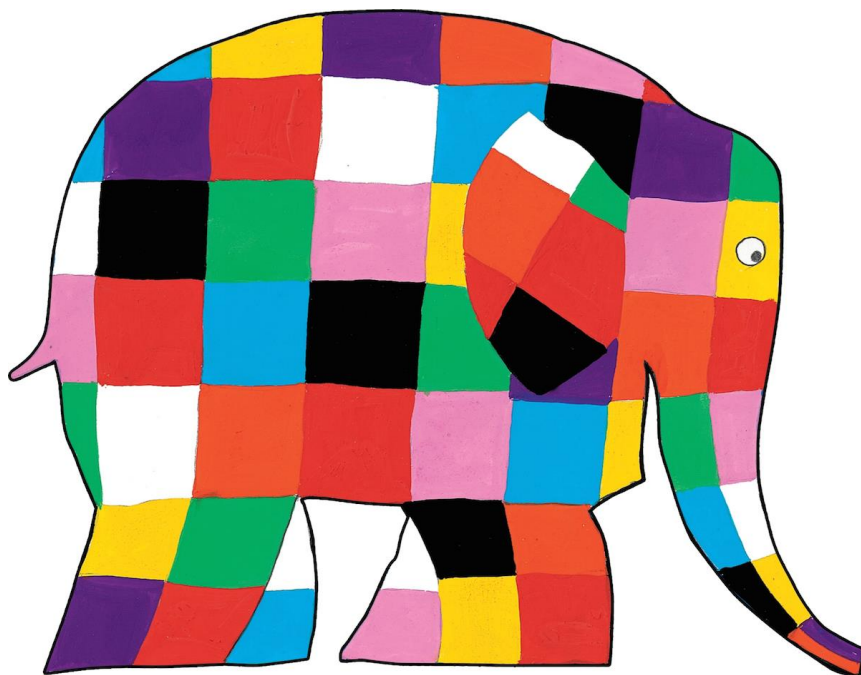

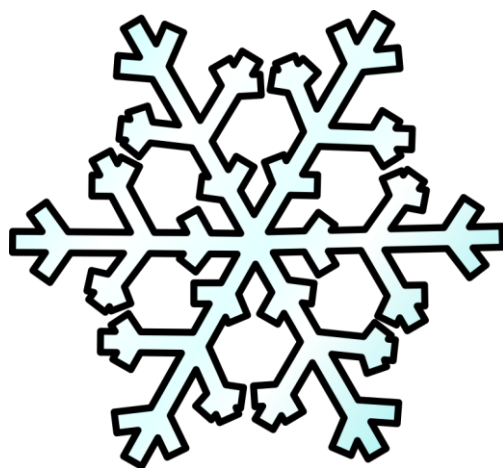


You can support your child's learning at home by:
