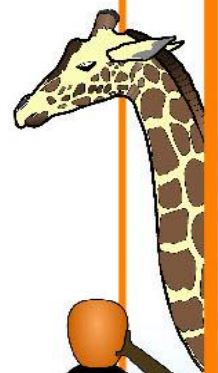
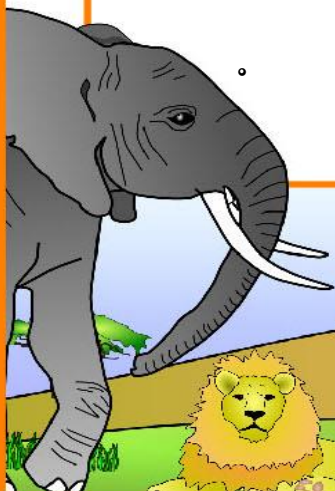
# Amazing Africa





This term we will be finding out about:

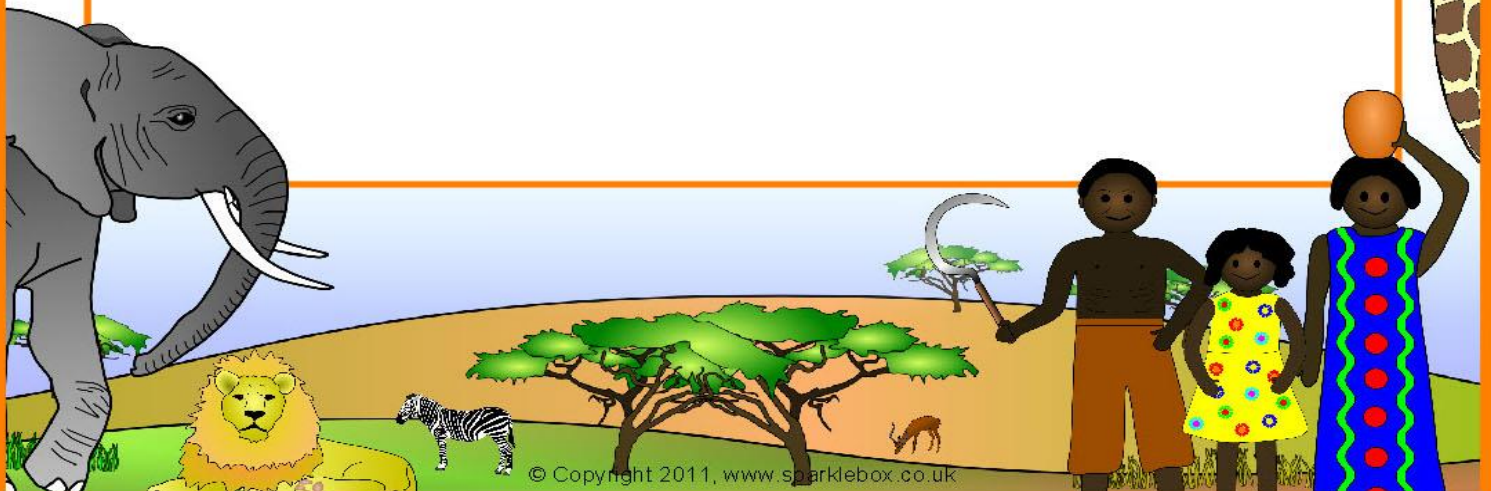
- Stories from other cultures

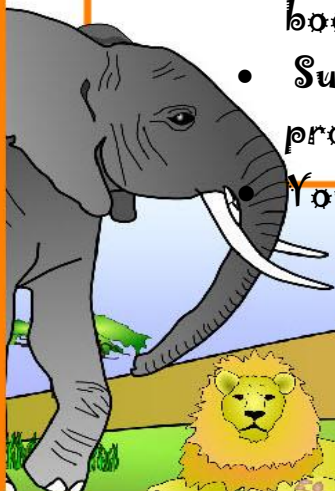
