# The Romans



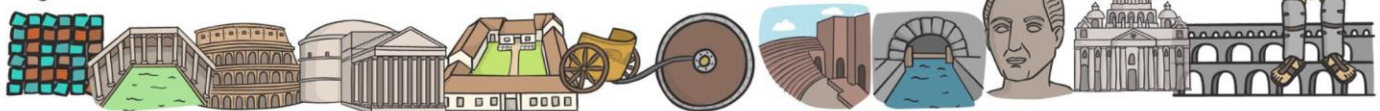


This term we will be finding out about:
