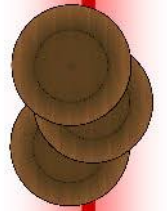
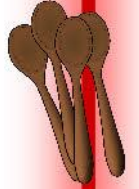
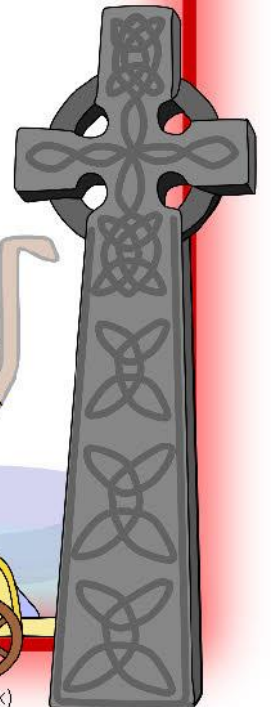
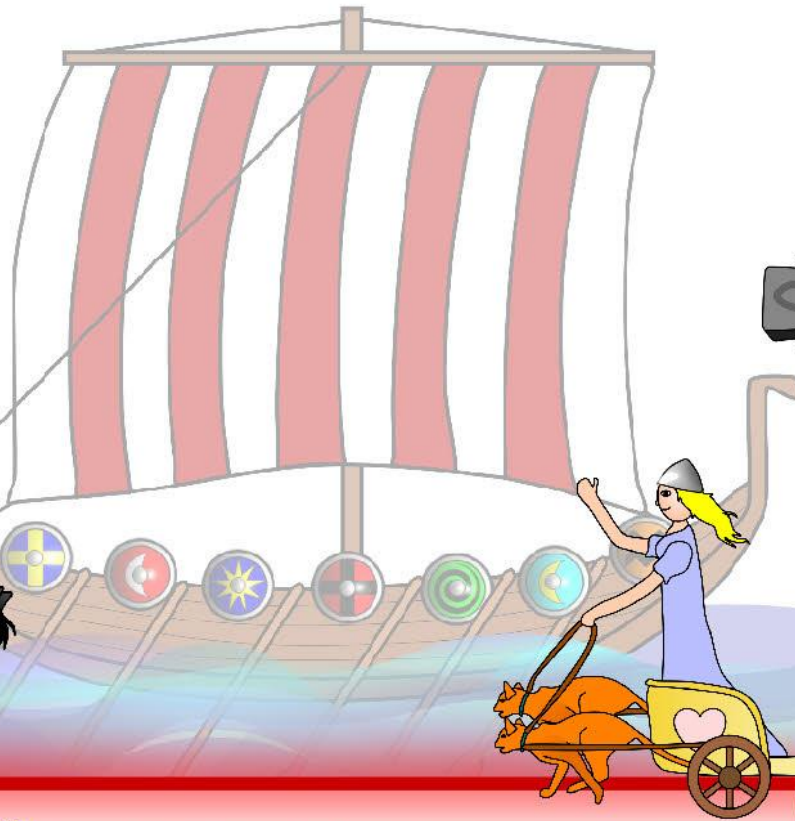
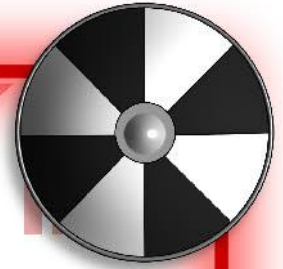
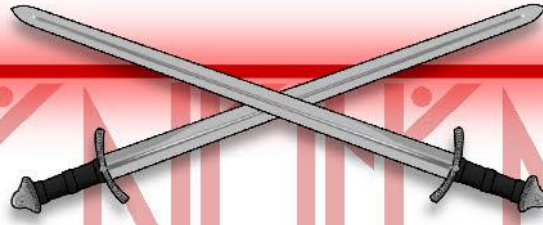


# Year 5 Spring Term

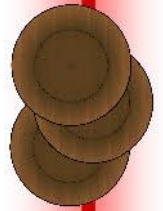
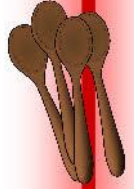


This term we will be finding out about:

- Jobs, housing and leisure during Anglo-Saxon and Viking times.

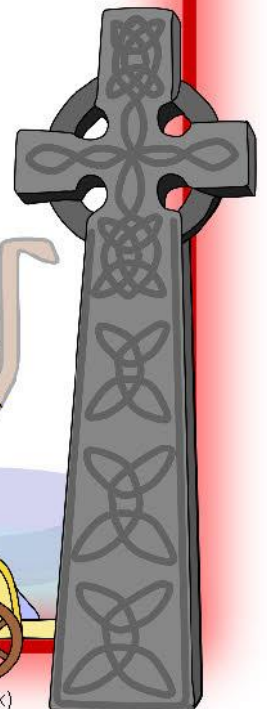


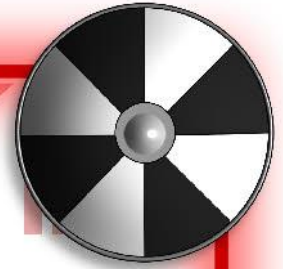
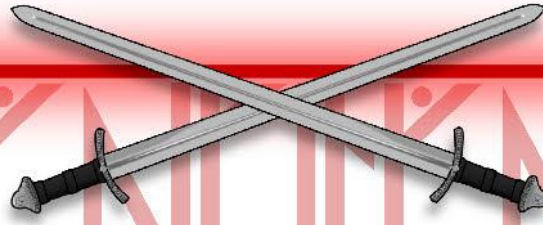
Our topic will begin with:

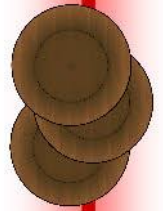
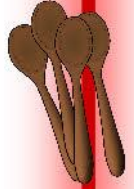




## Key information:
