



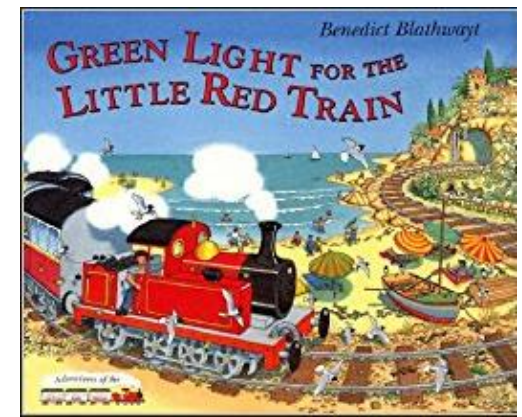
What are we learning this week 2nd May!

This week we are looking at the story of 'Green Light for the Little Red Train' by Benedict Blathwayt. We will be looking at the types of Trains from locomotives and rails.

Using different sized boxes to make a variety of trains on the Junk modelling table.

Role playing in the train station, turn taking to who is the ticket master and who is travelling on the train. Making their own tickets for the conductor.

In KUW - Nursery will be using magnets, looking at how a magnet pulls and pushes objects along. We will use the magnets to see which items in the classroom are magnetic.



In maths we will be matching the shapes on the train. Talking about if they have sides or they are round.

Looking at 2d and 3d shapes.

In literacy we will be going down to the library to find factual books on trains, looking at the different types all over the world.
