

What are we learning this week 6th March!

This week we are continuing with our topic of Panda goes around the world with a focus on Egypt. In art, we will be using lots of Gold and jewels to make our beautiful necklaces like the Pharaohs used to wear. We will be looking at the Ancient Egypt and discovering their hidden treasure.

We shall be celebrating World Maths day on Thursday 9th March, The children are invited to wear something with numbers or shapes on.

In Literacy - We will be using the sand to mark make, looking at the Egyptian Hieroglyphics and have a try at writing some Hieroglyphics.

In KUW - Focusing on the map of Egypt looking at where it is and what surrounds the country.



In maths - We will be print painting using the different tropical fruits and looking at the shapes they make. We will be looking at the shapes and using vocabulary related to 2D and 3D properties such as 'flat' or 'solid'.

In Expressive Arts - We will be creating collages of the Egyptian flag and the sacred scarab beetle. We will talk about their culture and look at the pyramids.
