



What are we learning this week 13th March!

This week is national science week! Nursery will be heading off in to space taking Panda on a far away journey into the Galaxy. We will get to explore what it is like to be an Astronaut, how they walk, what they need to wear, looking at the planets and stars and we blast off in our rocket.

The Nursery will have their Astronaut training where we will be making our vests, jumping onboard our rocket, moving around like we are walking in space, making space food and guiding their balloon space rocket around space obstacles.

In maths the children will be making their own space buggies, moving them across the moon craters. We will look at who's travels the fastest, which goes the furthest and if they can make predictions.
