

What are we learning this week?

This week we will be concluding our topic on Fairy Tales before the Chicks arrive in school. We shall be focusing on the story of Cinderella. In Literacy we will be writing character profiles of both Cinderella and the Ugly Sisters. This should allow for lots of work on using descriptive language. We shall also be drawing and writing story maps to help the children sequence traditional tales. Throughout the week, we will be showing the children how to write invitations to the ball!

In art, we will be making papier mache balloons which will be turned into 'pumpkin carriages!'

We will also be making paper plate clocks and wands. Later in the week, the children will be using paper plates and making them into glittery carriages.



We have some exciting Child Initiated Tasks planned this week, including:

- Using pink playdough to measure out different lengths of 'mice tails'. The children will be encouraged to use cubes to compare the different lengths.
- In Maths this week, we will have a focus on time to fit in with the story of Cinderella. You may like to start looking at clocks at home and sharing o'clock times that your children get up, have breakfast etc.
