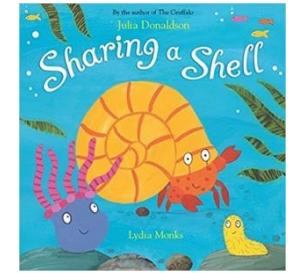


What are we learning this week? 26/6/17
