

What are we learning this week?

This week we will be looking at the story of The Bad Tempered Ladybird. We will have a focus this week of sequencing the story and encouraging the children to put the story into their own sentences. Working with an adult, the children will then be encouraged to sound out the words in their sentences and write them as a narrative. If you have this story at home, you may like to read it together and look at some of the vocabulary used. We will also be looking at how to write speech bubbles and record what the Bad Tempered Ladybird said.

In art, we will be making grass scenes with fingerprint ladybirds. We will also be making 3D ladybirds, clocks and potato print ladybirds. If you would like to research any ladybird facts with your child at home we would love to see them in school. Thank you.
